**Speaker Bio: Dave Mazza, Regional , Director, Pennsylvania Resources Council**

David Mazza is a lifelong resident of the City of Pittsburgh and has always had an interest in the region's environmental issues. As the former Recycling Coordinator for the City of Pittsburgh, he directed the city's recycling efforts throughout 90's and became active in many of the area's environmental efforts through his position with the city. He lists among his accomplishments with the city the expansion of the city's office paper and yard waste recycling programs, implementation of a scrap metal recycling program and creation of an award winning recycling education campaign. In 2000 he became the Western Regional Director for the Pennsylvania Resources Council to pursue his goal of improving the environmental quality of life in the region through education and outreach. Since coming to PRC Dave has worked to start an Allegheny County Chapter of PA Cleanways, implement the Debug D'Burgh Anti-litter Campaign, introduce a number of new in-school and adult environmental education programs, facilitate a region wide Household Hazardous Waste collection and bring nationally recognized programs such as EarthForce and WasteCap to the region.

In addition to being on the Allegheny County PACW Chapter advisory board, Dave also serves as the treasurer of the Construction Junction board, is a member of the Allegheny County Recycling Advisory Committee, the Chair of the SW PA HHW Task Force and on Mayor Murphy's Pittsburgh Clean Neighborhood Collaborative along with his involvement in the Riversweep, Pittsburgh's Picking Up and Stash Your Trash annual cleanup events. In his spare time he enjoys participating in the vintage musclecar hobby and spending time with his wife Donna.
