Mr. Gershman currently serves as Project Manager for the City of Alexandria/Arlington county Waste Disposal Trust Fund and Project Administrator for the Metro Nashville District Energy System. He recently helped develop a 200,000 ton per year mixed paper processing facility in Montgomery County, Maryland and is advising the City of Fort Worth, Texas and Nashville, Tennessee on major changes to their solid waste management services. He has provided expert witness services on flow control and economic-related issues. He is the primary author and instructor for SWANA's "Paying for Your System" Course. He is a past member of the Board of Directors for SWANA and the Maryland Recyclers Coalition (MRC) and served as its President during 1995-1997. In 1993, Mr. Gershman received SWANA's Professional Achievement Award.
