Speaker Bio: Remy Esquenet is Director of Fiber Recovery and Utilization for the American Forest & Paper Association (AF&PA)

Before joining AF&PA, Remy was an attorney in private practice working on issues of environmental law. Previous to that, he worked at the White House's Office of the Federal Environmental Executive where he dealt with policy issues relating to recycling, procurement and waste prevention.

Remy also was a consultant and contractor to NASA, the U.S. Navy, the U.S. Army, and some municipalities and businesses on projects involving waste minimization, hazardous materials management, pollution prevention and recycling.

He received his Bachelor of Science in Environmental Health from Old Dominion University. His law degree is from American University's Washington College of Law.
