**Speaker Bio: Sibyl Pappas, SCS Engineers**

Sibyl is a contractor to EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP), a voluntary program designed to promote the use of landfill gas as energy. Sibyl works with Meg Victor of the USEPA on Territory 1, which includes the northeastern portion of the United States from Maine extending south to Virginia and as far west as Michigan.

As a territory manager, Sibyl works to create effective partnerships between the LMOP and states, utilities, landfill owners and operators, communities, and key leaders in the landfill gas industry. Sibyl also assists landfill gas project development by helping landfills find beneficial end uses for the landfill gas, and by providing technical and marketing assistance at all stages of the development process.

Sibyl joined SCS Engineers in 1996 and has been working with the LMOP since that time. Sibyl became a territory manager in 1999.
