Robin is the Executive Director of the Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority in Baltimore, Maryland. The Authority is a regional governmental organization serving Baltimore City and seven Counties. Over 4 million people live in the Authority's region. The Authority has developed and financed three waste-to-energy (WTE) facilities and one sewage sludge composting facility, and two of the three facilities are owned by the Authority.

In addition to managing these facilities, the Authority procures, negotiates and manages numerous service contracts and construction projects. The Authority assists its members with the disposal of over 1 million tons of solid waste and the composting of 42,000 tons of sewage sludge each year. The Authority is nationally recognized for its pioneer work in negotiating short-term energy contracts and marketing renewable energy credits.

Robin has written articles for Waste Age Magazine and National Defense Magazine.

Robin holds a Masters Degree in Regional Planning from the University of Pennsylvania. She recently completed the Kennedy School of Government's Strategic Public Sector Negotiations course.
