OUR PURPOSE

- Provide unemployed, underemployed and dislocated workers with access to workforce training via online courses for retraining and reemployment
- Partner with local agencies to produce custom courses and/or learn center portals to meet workforce training requirements for new hire, retention and advancement.

IN THE BEGINNING (2010 - 2011)

- Workforce Training Department launched July 1, 2010
- The first paid online enrollment occurred in August 2010 – GED Course
- Fiscal year consisted of 861 paid course enrollments to include 727 Teacherline enrollments
- Purchase and customization of a learning management system.
- First Custom Learn Center Portal launched for Nevada Chapter of the Society of Human Resources (January 2011)



One Year Later (2011-2012)

- Vegas PBS received Bank of America's \$200,000 Neighborhood Builder Award to launch the Workforce Initiative.
- Fiscal year 1265 enrollments to include 518 Teacherline enrollments
- Created a custom training portal for the Southern Nevada Health
 District and launched a BETA pilot from January 2012 March
 2012 for the food safety training. Soft opening to the portal April
 2012.
- Finalized production and launched Ronna Timpa's Hotel English Online April 2012
- Created and launched the custom portal for the High Sierra
 Health Education Center providing health education to the health
 care industry April 2012.



A YEAR AFTER - Continued (2011-2012)

- Vegas PBS Workforce become a National Testing Center with National HealthCareers to provide high stakes testing for healthcare careers – April 2012
- Course and Program offerings go from 800 to over 5,000 covering most occupational careers.



Today (2012-2013)

- Fiscal year current enrollments currently stand at over 105,000 as of May 31, to include 398
 Teacherline enrollments
- Public announcement and launch of Southern Nevada Health District Learn Center July 1 and e-Commerce enabled September 1 2012.
- SNHD Program alone accounts for more than 104,000 enrollments with an anticipated 10,000 additional enrollments by June 30, 2013.
- Creation of customized Ronna Timpa's Hotel English Online learn center in response to group sales December 2013



PRESENT TIMES (2012-2013) - Continued

- Workforce Department receives a \$50,000 grant from Caesars Foundation and launches Caesars Back-to-Work program – November 2013 and are currently serving 150 students in GED, ESL and workforce certification courses.
- Development and launch of the Nevada Mentor Learn Center Portal in partnership with CCSD Partnership Office funded by NV Energy and MGM in February 2013 and anticipate over 600 mentors and mentees in the program by the end of next year.
