

## The latest on VITA from the field

- Engaged in field research over the past year on VITA and its impact on the EITC
- Resulted in two new publications with insights from the VITA practitioner and funder perspectives
- Key takeaways for local governments:
  - 1. Multiplier effect
  - 2. Pathways to implement vision
  - 3. VITA improved by learning across cities/states/partnerships
  - 4. Funders are deeply committed to this work







### What Mayors can do

Promote VITA throughout the year

- Develop direct relationships with local VITA sites and serve as a convener across organizations
- Encourage integrated service delivery
- Advocate for free tax prep services and expanding the EITC or creating a state EITC



#### What Mayors have already done

- Boston Mayor Martin J. Walsh championed the Boston Tax Help Coalition, a public-private partnership of 30+ organizations that providing VITA services and advocating to expand the state EITC
- Detroit Mayor Mike Duggan joined with Accounting Aid Society (AAS), the IRS, United Way for Southeastern Michigan, and community organizations to launch an EITC outreach and education campaign
- Philadelphia Mayor Jim Kenney signed a bill to expand employers' notice requires regarding the federal EITC and launched the "You Earned It" campaign to support EITC outreach
