#### Charges, Rates, Fees

A jurisdiction sets a **rate** of \$5 per month for compost service. That rate produces an annual **fee** of \$60 per household. That amount appears as part of the broader solid waste **charge** on the utility bill.




#### Fees

- Commercial / Residential
- Linked to specific service
- Paid by users
- Based on cost
- Set by law or ordinance
- Requires management and review

**City Sales Tax** Varies with Monthly Use

### Solid Waste Management Fees

Fee Type	Example
Flat	Monthly base fee for curbside collection
Variable	Pay-As-You-Throw (PAYT)
Subscription	Optional recurring fee for food waste collection services
Special Service	One-time fee for composting service at special event
Surcharge	Extra charge for sending waste to the landfill or incinerator


# **Subscription Fee**

- Optional service
- Recurring
- Separate from base service
- Focus on waste diversion



#### **Special Service Fee**

- Charge for an additional or extraordinary service not included in regular service offerings
- Designed to cover the costs of providing a unique or non-standard service
- Example: compost bin service for special events



#### Surcharge

- Additional charge
- Specific purpose
- Mandatory
- Financial supplement
- Impact behavior
